Wall Covering Install, Repair & Removal

Processes of Wall Covering Install

1. Determine what area you would like to install the wall covering on.
2. Select the brand and your design.
3. Remove existing wall covering if necessary, prep all imperfections and prime with a bonding primer.
4. Take measurements, cut and install.
5. Cut all edges on all four corners and push all bubbles or areas that have air so wall covering lies onto the wall evenly.

Process of Wall Covering Repair

1. Determine the area that needs to be repaired.
2. Protect floor and items within surrounding areas with plastic.
3. If it's a loose piece of wall covering just glue it back in place by using wall covering glue, and sponge off excess glue.
4. If it's a piece that needs to be replaced; Cut out that torn piece that needs to be replaced, and just replace it with a new piece of wall covering, with using wall covering glue, and sponge off excess glue.

Wall Covering Install, Repair & Removal

Process of Wall Covering Removal

1. Determine what area of removal of wall covering.
2. Protect floor and items within surrounding areas with plastic.
3. Spray the wall covering with water or wall covering removal with garden sprayer.
4. Scrape with a knife to start removing the old wall covering.
5. Repeat until it's all removed.
6. Clean the surface with a sponge to remove any left over glue or wall covering.
7. Clean the area and then you're done.
